Subject: REVISION TO AUXILIARY POLICE GUIDE 6-2, "UNIT RANK STRUCTURE AND DUTIES"

1. If an Auxiliary Police Unit while on patrol comes upon a pick up incident, the Auxiliary Police Unit must immediately notify the communications dispatcher. The communications dispatcher will then immediately assign a patrol unit to the scene. Communications Dispatcher will not assign Auxiliary Police Units to any 911 incidents. Final Dispositions will not be accepted from Auxiliary Police Units.

2. Therefore, effective immediately, Auxiliary Police Guide 6-2, "UNIT RANK STRUCTURE AND DUTIES" is amended as follows:

a. **REVISE AUXILIARY POLICE OFFICER DUTIES** statement on step "8", page "2" to read:

8. Members of the Auxiliary Police are prohibited from responding to police assignments.

3. Any provisions of the Auxiliary Police Guide or any other Department directive in conflict with the contents of this Order are suspended.
