**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUXILIARY POLICE MEMBERS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ANNUAL POLICE ARLINGTON MEMORIAL SERVICE**

1. The New York City Police Department's Traffic Squad Benevolent Association has invited uniformed auxiliary police members to attend the 3<sup>rd</sup> annual Police Arlington Memorial Service on Saturday May 21, 2011 at the Cypress Hills Cemetery, Brooklyn, New York. **Accordingly, auxiliary members from patrol boroughs Brooklyn and Queens are asked to attend this service.**

2. The memorial service pays tribute to those fallen police officers of the Metropolitan Police Department, many of whom were veterans of the Civil or Spanish-American Wars. For those who may not be aware, the Metropolitan Police Department is a predecessor agency of the New York City Police Department.

3. All Patrol Borough Brooklyn and Patrol Borough Queens **Auxiliary Police Coordinators** are to survey their personnel to determine the number of Auxiliary Police members who will attend this memorial service. **Coordinators** will provide their **respective borough level coordinators** with this information by **Tuesday May 10, 2011.**

4. **Borough Auxiliary Coordinators** will collect and provide this information to the Brooklyn and Queens Auxiliary Police Section Liaisons by **Tuesday May 17, 2011.** All auxiliary members attending this service will report as follows:


DATE: Saturday May 21, 2011
