**SUBJECT: AUXILIARY PATROL SUPPORT UNIT (APSU)**


1. Effective immediately, all AUXILIARY PATROL SUPPORT UNIT(S) (APSU) personnel are transferred to their respective command patrol units, e.g., members of the 7<sup>th</sup> Pct. APSU to the 7<sup>th</sup> Precinct Auxiliary Patrol unit, 30<sup>th</sup> Pct. APSU to the 30<sup>th</sup> Precinct Auxiliary Patrol unit and so on for all of the nine units. Furthermore, members will retain their rank and be guided by the precinct commanding officer and auxiliary police coordinator for patrol duties and assignments as per needs of the command.

2. Additionally, if any auxiliary member desires a transfer to another command, they must comply with Auxiliary Guide Procedure No. 3-14, *Transfers*. Any request for such transfer will be at the discretion of the Commanding Officer, Auxiliary Police Section. It should be noted that rank structure within the requested command will be taken into consideration before any transfer request is approved.

3. Furthermore, the Auxiliary Patrol Support Unit (APSU) uniform is no longer authorized equipment and can no longer be worn. All members must comply with Auxiliary Guide Chapter No. 5, *UNIFORMS AND EQUIPMENT*, as it pertains to their new assignment.

4. Any provisions of the Auxiliary Guide or other Auxiliary Police Section directive in conflict with the contents of this Order are suspended.
